








The female faculty members at AIPS engage in a friendly game of table tennis





This made the Women Empowerment Cell think of conducting a webinar on awareness program on PCOS issues, its reasons, precautions to be taken and solutions, for the knowledge of the girl students and women faculty. The resource person Dr.G.Roopa kala having a great experience in dealing with all gynae issues explained about polycystic ovarian syndrome that it is only a syndrome but not a disease, which is a lifelong condition that continues far beyond childbearing years and can be simply controlled by a proper diet & lifestyle because the reason for this syndrome is mainly due to unhealthy diet and lack of physical exercise. Creating awareness about the symptoms and risk factors of PCOS can lead to earlier detection and diagnosis. Timely identification of PCOS is crucial for managing the condition effectively and preventing potential complications. She said irregular/ delayed periods, excess facial hair can be considered as symptoms. Dr.G.Roopa kala

threw light on the solution for this problem - eating a balanced, low carbohydrate high protein diet to lose weight & increasing physical activity helps a lot to come out of this issue, she said. Before the program ended, some of the women faculty & girl students asked some questions which were answered very patiently by Dr.G.Roopa kala.70 members have been attended the webinar. 




