Introduction:

On, 12-09-2022 an Awareness program on dengue and unhygienic environmental conditions was organized by 3rd Pharm.D students of Avanthi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences at Chittivalasa. 



Introduction: On 11-05-2022 an Outreach Program on Motivating local shopkeepers to Ban plastic has been conducted by 3rd year and 4th year B-Pharm students along with 2 faculty members (Dr.B.Manoj kumar, Dr.T.Rushi Naidu) of AIPS. 30 Students have addressed local shopkeepers of nearly 40 shops in Cherukupally village creating awareness with banners about disadvantages and harm caused by usage of plastic. Plastic pollution is a major issue in today's growing population of Cherukupally village. Most conventional plastics are non-biodegradable, meaning they do not break down easily in the environment. They can persist in the environment for hundreds of years, causing long-term pollution and ecological damage. As the population continues to grow, the challenges posed by plastic waste will likely intensify, necessitating concerted efforts to mitigate its environmental impact for the well-being of ecosystems and future generations.

In response to the pressing environmental concerns associated with plastic usage, a group of Pharmacy students from Avanthi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences initiated a campaign to motivate local shopkeepers in Cherukupally to ban plastic. The campaign aimed to raise awareness about the detrimental effects of plastic on the environment and encourage sustainable alternatives.

Campaign Activities:

The students organized a series of activities on 11-05-2022, to engage the local shopkeepers and promote the plastic ban initiative:


Conclusion:




