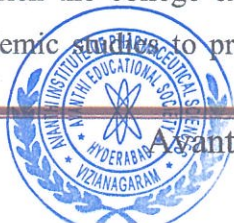
### Title of the practice: CAAS (Career Advisory and Augmentation Services)
