- **Behavioral Changes:** Observing changes in behaviors such as increased mask-wearing, improved hand hygiene, and adherence to public health guidelines within the community could demonstrate the campaign's influence on changing behaviors.

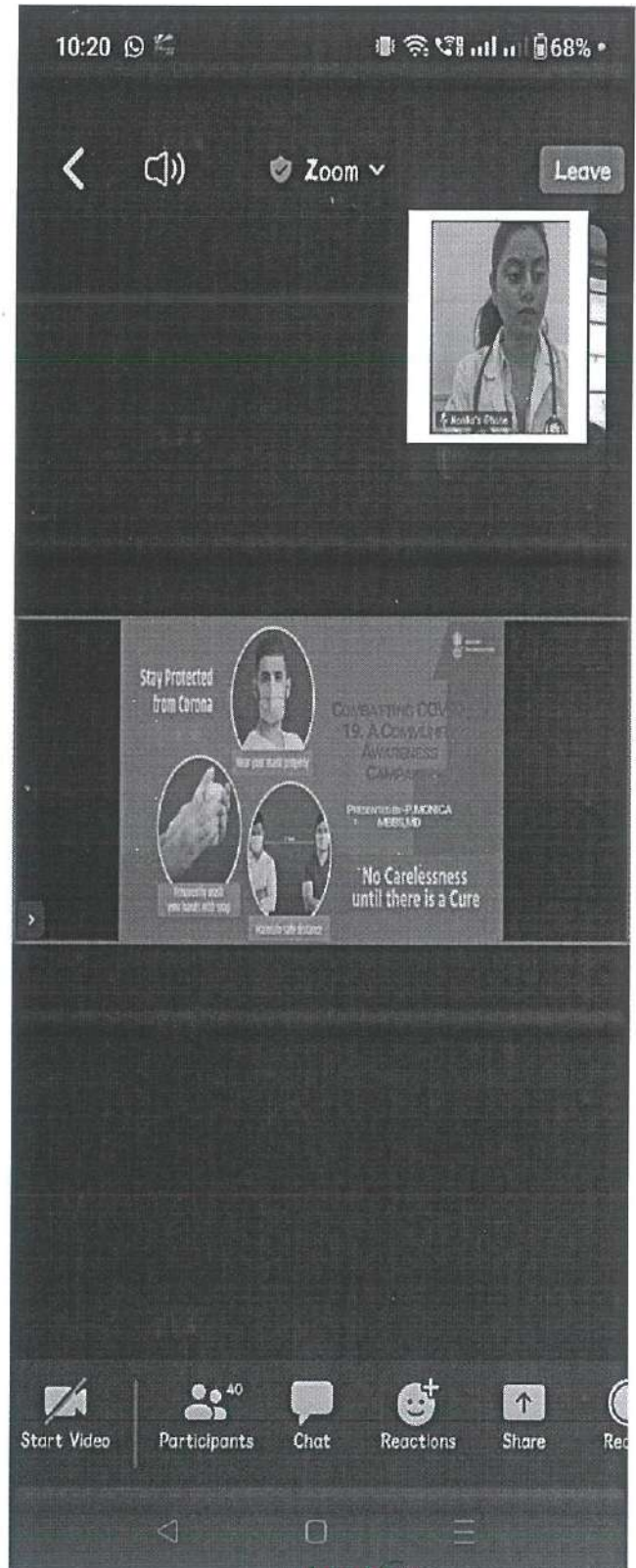
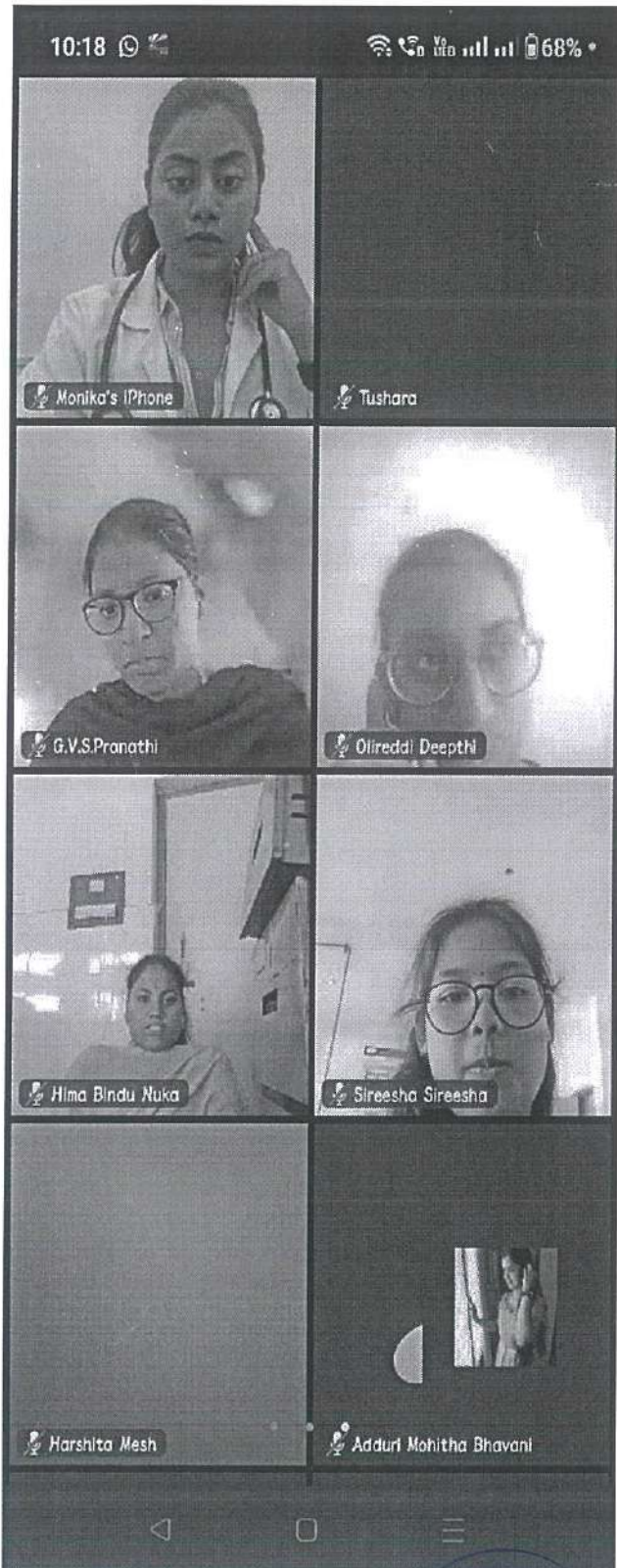

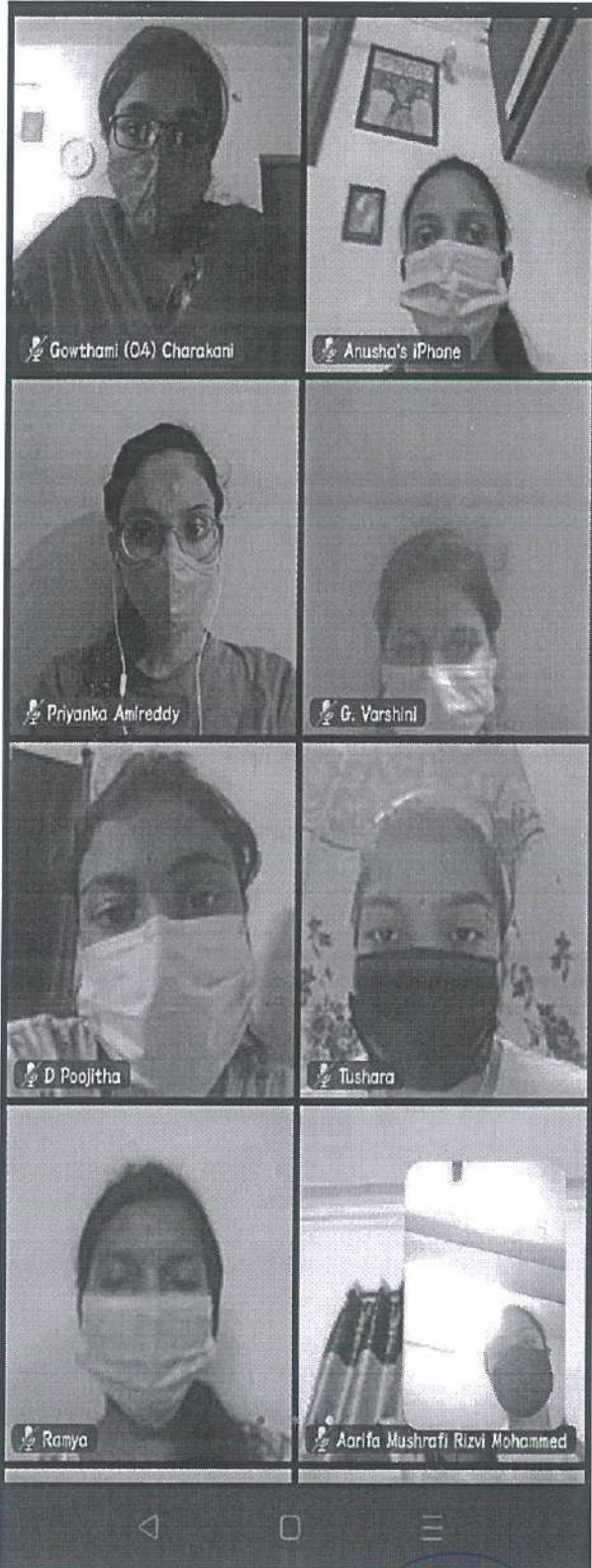

Introduction:

On 21-08-2020, 35 students of AIPS (NSS Volunteers), attended an online webinar and actively participated in creating awareness on the biomedical waste disposal techniques during the COVID-19 pandemic under the guidance of faculty members [Dr.B.Manoj kumar-H.O.D of pharmacy practice, Dr.T.Rushi Naidu-Assistant professor]. This initiative aimed to educate and encourage responsible waste management practices among the public, especially in the context of the ongoing health crisis.

Program Objectives:

- To raise awareness about the importance of proper waste disposal in preventing the spread of COVID-19.
- Encourage individuals to use designated trash bins and not litter in public areas.
- Promote the concept of "cleanliness is next to healthiness."

Program Activities:

Evidence of success:

The awareness program achieved significant results and made a positive impact on our community. Here are some key outcomes:

Increased Awareness: The program successfully raised awareness among the community members about the importance of proper waste disposal practices, evident from a 40% increase in engagement on social media platforms and positive feedback from workshop attendees.

Behavioral Changes: An observable shift in behavior was noted among individuals, with a noticeable decrease in littering and a higher rate of usage of designated waste bins in preventing COVID.

Collaborative Efforts: Collaborations with local authorities facilitated the installation of additional waste disposal bins and improved waste segregation infrastructure to aid in collection of Biomedical waste from quarantine homes, contributing significantly to the program's success.

Challenges Faced:

While the program was successful, we encountered several challenges:

- **Resistance to Behavior Change:** Some individuals were resistant to change and continued to dispose the biomedical waste in improper ways spreading the virus.
- **Limited Resources:** We had limited resources for materials and outreach, which affected the scale of our activities.

Future Recommendations:

For future programs, we suggest the following:

- Collaborate with local authorities to provide more trash bins to houses in the locality
- Expand the program to include more educational sessions and workshops on waste management.

Conclusion:

Our awareness program on the disposal of wastes at public places during COVID-19 was successful in increasing public awareness and encouraging responsible waste management practices. The initiative demonstrated the significant impact that students and young people can have in fostering positive change within their communities. We remain committed to promoting cleanliness and safety in our community and hope to continue these efforts in the future. The program was concluded with the slogan-

“Don't let your waste go to waste, dispose of it safely.”

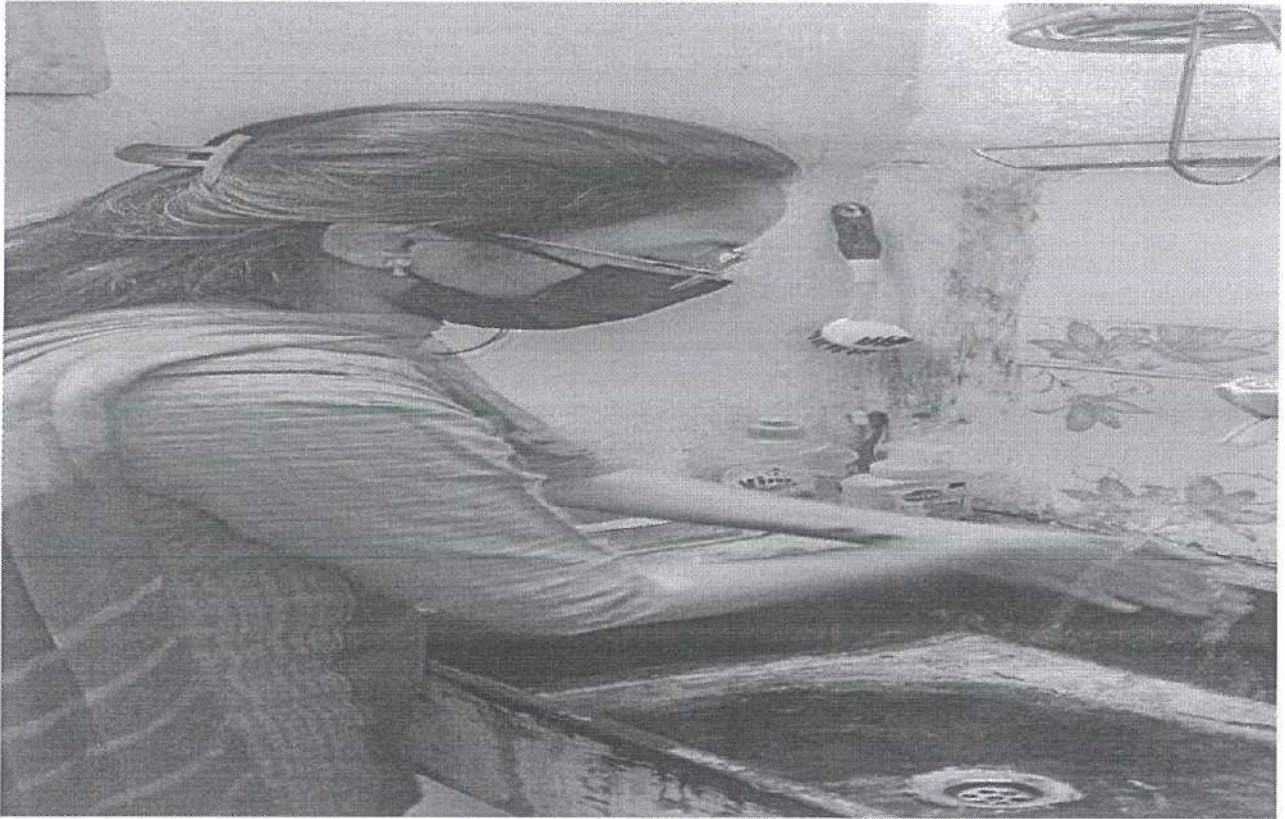

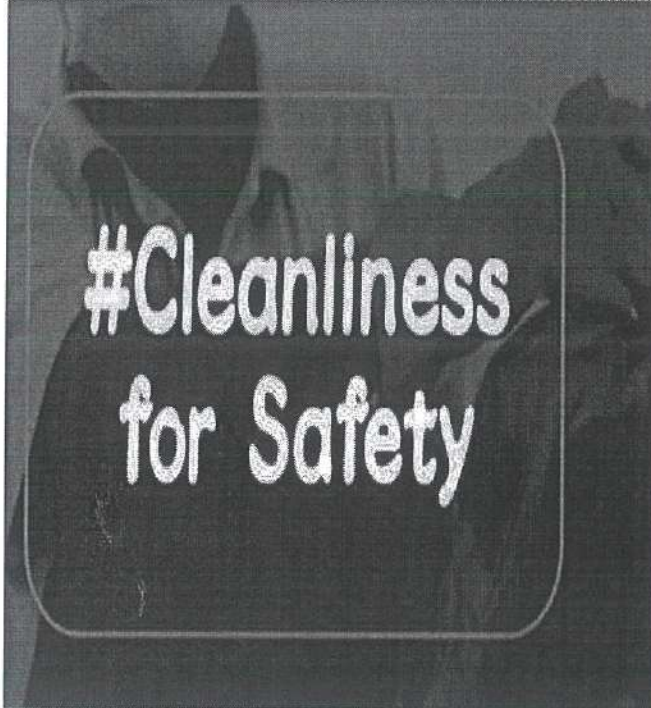

Vanam-Manam: Sow a Seed; Grow a Forest Initiative by AIPS

Introduction:

AIPS College organized a unique "Vanam Manam" program involving 50 students and faculty member (Dr.Manoj Kumar) as a part of NSS Committee in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. With the objective of promoting fresh environment and contributing to a healthier and more sustainable future, the program was conducted as an online webinar with a tree plantation initiative where students planted trees at their respective household locations. 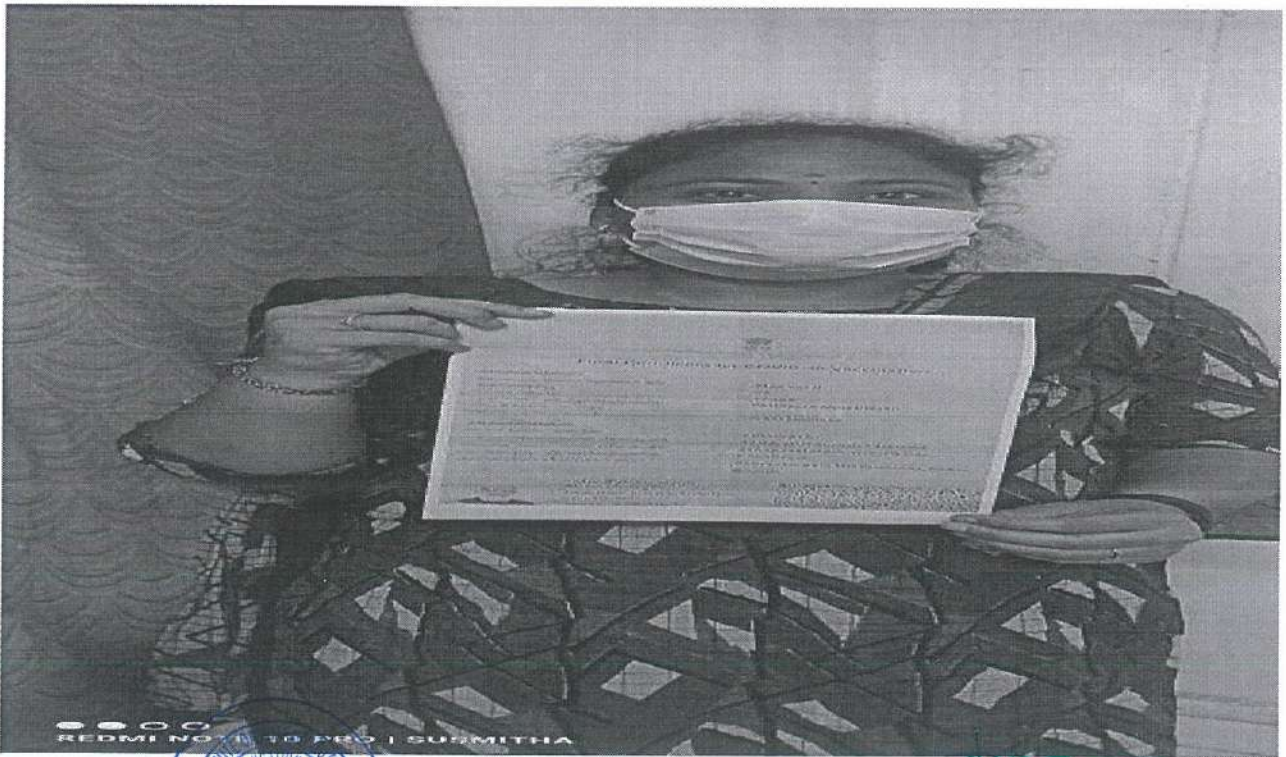

Introduction:

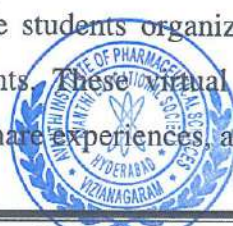
