- J. Claim Submission Protocol: Any claims or grievances must be submitted in writing through the proper channel to the competent authority. Forwarding advance copies to higher authorities is prohibited unless the competent authority has rejected the competent authority.






Annual Awareness Program on Code of Conduct for AIPS Faculty by Principal


